

BETHANY PRAYER JOB DESCRIPTIONS

CHURCH PRAYER COORDINATOR

The mission of the Congregational Prayer Coordinator is to encourage, facilitate, and enhance the practice of prayer and intercession (including prayer for the lost) in Bethany Church.

Goals

1. Develop a prayer leadership team. Each team member is responsible for one or more prayer ministries in the church.
2. Identify, train, and network those in the church with the gift of intercession.
3. Increase the frequency, consistency, and intensity of prayer in the ministry of the church, among the church staff and leaders, in the worship and fellowship of the congregation, and in the lives of individual members.
4. Promote participation in local, regional, denominational, and national prayer initiatives.

Responsibilities

1. Work closely and cooperatively with the church's leadership to plan, implement, and enhance the church's prayer ministry.
2. Hold regular meetings (at least quarterly) of the prayer team to coordinate current prayer ministries, to discuss and develop new prayer ministries as God leads, and to intercede for the ministry and members.
3. Coordinate Bethany's Prayer Warriors: identify, train, and network those with the gift of intercession.
4. Promote the practice of prayer in all aspects of Bethany's ministry-among the leaders, members, and community; within worship, small groups, and team meetings; both personally and corporately.
5. Supervise and coordinate the prayer room and prayer line.
6. Provide a strong prayer shield for leadership.
7. Intercede daily for Bethany Church.
8. Coordinate the Wednesday evening prayer meeting.
9. Promote participation in local, regional, denominational, and national prayer initiatives.

Qualities

1. Has a personal relationship with God through Jesus Christ.
2. Is a person of prayer.
3. Desires to strengthen fellow believers' personal walk with God as well as bring in the lost to be discipled.
4. Is willing to be a team player and to submit to lines of authority.
5. Possesses the spiritual gifts of leadership, administration, encouragement, and intercession.
6. Has a passion for intercession and evangelism.

CAMP PRAYER COORDINATORS

The mission of the CAMP Prayer Coordinator is to encourage, facilitate, and enhance the practice of prayer and intercession (including prayer for the lost) in the CAMP as well as communicate specific needs and thanksgivings to the larger Bethany community.

Goals

1. To increase the frequency, consistency, and intensity of prayer in the ministry of the CAMP, among the church staff and leaders, in the worship and fellowship of the congregation, and in the lives of individual members through communication, modeling, and training.
2. To provide the link of communication of prayer needs and thanksgivings from the CAMP to the larger Bethany body.
3. To provide a core group of intercessors as well as equippers in the Bethany prayer ministry.

Responsibilities

1. Work closely and cooperatively with the CAMP leadership team as well as the Bethany Prayer team to plan, implement, and enhance the prayer ministry.
2. Hold regular meetings (at least quarterly) of the prayer team to coordinate current prayer ministries to discuss, evaluate, and develop new ministries as God leads to intercede for the ministry and members.
3. Coordinate Bethany's prayer warriors: identify, train, and network those with the gift of intercession.
4. Intercede daily on behalf of the CAMP ministry and its members.
5. Promote participation in local, regional, denominational, and prayer initiatives.
6. Serve as a hub of the CAMP's communication of members' needs and thanksgivings.
7. Participate in the Prayer Ministry of Bethany by serving as a champion in one of the following areas:
 - Promotion (special days),
 - Prayer Room,
 - Recruitment/Training,
 - Communication through Prayer Line/WEB,
 - Communication through Prayer Sheet,
 - Coordinating prayer shield for leadership,
 - Coordination of prayer cells/ meetings.
